



### **CLASS 1 - Leadline Equitation- Walk**

Class for children lacking experience to handle horses off a lead. Children 8 and under. Experienced quiet horses only! Flat class judged on equitation of the rider.

### **Class 2 - Walk/Trot Ground Rails Warm Up**

Warm Up with the same course for the Walk/Trot Ground Rails division. Class is pinned, but it does not count for points towards Reserve Champion and Champion for the division (Division is classes 3,4,and 5).

### **Class 3 and 4 - Walk/Trot Ground Rails**

For inexperienced horses or riders not yet ready to canter. Course will be simple with one direction change and eight poles. Only to be ridden in either walk or trot or a combination of both. Judged as a Hunter Class, equitation of the rider and quiet, willingness of horse to do the task. Division Awards for Champ and Reserve Champ for those entered in all three classes, excludes warm up class.

### **Class 5 - Walk / Trot U/S**

Flat class for the Walk/Trot Division

### **Class 6- Walk/Trot Cross Rails Cross Rails Warm Up**

Warm Up round with the same course for the 12" Cross Rails Division, class is pinned, but it will not count towards the overall points for Reserve Champion and Champion in the 12" Cross Rails division. (Division is classes 7,8 and 9)

### **Class 7 and Class 8- Walk / Trot Cross Rails O/F**

For riders or horses having little jumping experience. To be completed in the Trot with no jumping or cantering. Course will be simple cross rails (white) and simple course with two changes of direction across the diagonal.

### **Class 9 - Walk/ Trot U/S**

Flat class for the 12" Cross Rails division.

### **Class 10 - Canter Cross Rails Warm Up**

Warm Up round with the same course for the 12" Cross Rails division. Points for this class will not count towards division overall points towards Reserve Champion and Champion, but it will be pinned.(Division is classes 11,12, and 13).

### **Classes 11 and Class 12 - Canter Cross Rails O/F**

For Riders or horses with some experience jumping fences. To be completed in the Canter over 12" Cross Rails. Course will have two direction changes with eight simple fences with no fill.

### **Class 13 - Canter Cross Rails U/S**

Flat class for the extremely green Hunter division. Walk, Trot, and Canter.

### **Class 14 - Extremely Green Rider 18" Vertical Warm Up**

Warm up round for the 18" Vertical division with the same course as the division. Points will not count towards Reserve Champion and Champion for the division, but it will be pinned. (Division is classes 15,16, and 17)

### **Class 15 and Class 16 - Extremely Green Rider 18" Verticals O/F**

For green horses or riders just starting to canter verticals in their first 2 years of showing. Course will have filler with eight fences and two directional changes. Riders will not be penalized for simple changes of leads.

### **Class 17 - Extremely Green Rider U/S**

Flat class for the 18" Verticals division.

### **Class 18 - 2' Short/Long Stirrup Hunter Warm Up**

Warm up class with the same course for the 2' Vertical division. Points will not count towards reserve Champion and Champion in the division, but it will be pinned.

### **Class 19 and Class 20- Short Stirrup O/F (Riders to be 12 years of age and younger)**

Open to riders 12 years of age and under with limited experience. Fences 2'.

### **Class 21 - Short Stirrup U/S**

Flat class for the 2' Division

### **Class 22 and 23 - Long Stirrup O/F**

Same course as Short Stirrup 2'. Riders to be 13 years of age and over with limited experience.

### **Class 24 - Long Stirrup U/S**



### **Beginner Hunter Rider**

Warm Up (Class 1), Division points are two O/F classes (Classes 2 & 3), one U/S (Class 4) Fence Height 2'. Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors and Amateurs with limited riding experience. To be judged on performance.

### **Low Intermediate Hunter 2'3" Division**

Warm Up (Class 5) Division points are Two O/F classes (6 and 7) , and one U/S Flat class (class 8) . Open to horses in their first two years of showing (not dependent on horse/rider combination). Judged on performance and soundness. Simple changes of lead not to be penalized.

### **Intermediate Hunter 2'6"**

Warm Up (Class 9) Division Points are two O/F Classes (Classes 10 & 11) and One U/S Flat class (Class 12 )

### **Hunter Derby Class**

(Class 13) One class at heights 2'3"-2'6" which contain fences with gates, coops, natural brush, Hay bales, natural logs, etc. Course will have a trot fence, higher option fence, and a rollback. One course plus a handy round.

### **Intro Jumper X Rails 18"**

One Warm up class (14), two jumping classes (Classes 15 & 16) that count for champ and reserve champ awards. Rounds are not timed, closest to optimum (either over or under) time posted for the round on the course map with a clean round determines the placings. No jump offs. **(Not MHJA Sanctioned)**

### **2' Green Jumper Division**

One warm Up class (17) and two jumping classes (18 & 19) that count for division points. Placings determined by closest to optimum time (either over or under) without faults, no jump offs in both classes. Optimum time to be posted on the jump course map. **(not MHJA Sanctioned)**

### **Puddle Jumper 2'3"**

Warm Up (20) and two timed jumping classes (21 & 22) that count for the division points, both will have jump offs. Fastest and clean jump offs will determine winners.

### **2'6" Beginner Jumper**

One warm up class (23), and two timed O/F classes (24 & 25) (count for division points).

### **2'9" Low Training Jumper**

One Warm up class (26), 2 O/F timed classes (27 & 28) (count for division points).

### **3' Training Jumper**

Warm Up (29), 2 O/F timed O/F classes for points (30 & 31)
